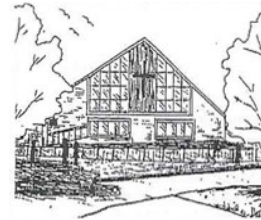

## SIXTEENTH SUNDAY OF THE YEAR (A)

19th July 2020

**Reading:** Wisdom 12:13, 16-19 **Second Reading:** Romans 8:26-27 **Gospel:** Matthew 13: 24-43

### GENERAL INFORMATION FOR THE CELEBRATION OF SUNDAY MASS

#### **BEFORE MASS**

- Please do not enter the premises if you or anyone you live with have any COVID-19 related symptoms. Follow the Government guidance to remain at home and self-isolate.
- On arrival/exit you will be directed by stewards to sanitize your hands.
- Register your name with the stewards in case of covid19 is the form track and tracing. Name will be kept for 21 days.
- Max in the Church is 120 people.
- No standing at the back.
- Place bring your own face mask.
- The toilet will be closed until further notice.
- There will be no singing.
- Bidding Prayer (Prayer of the Faithful) is omitted.
- There is no Procession with the Gifts of Bread and Wine.
- No Sign of Peace should be offered.
- The arrangements for Holy Communion will be somewhat different: - Before the priest receives the Host, he will hold it up and say: "The Body of Christ". Together, we all reply: "Amen".
- Before the priest receives from the Chalice, he will hold it up and say: "The Blood of Christ". Together, we all reply: "Amen".
- We come up to receive Holy Communion by the side aisles, which have been marked for social distancing.
- Communion is given in the hand only (palms upwards, one on top of the other, with arms at "full stretch" so there is a good distance between priest or Eucharistic minister and the person receiving communion).
- Communion is distributed one kind only and received in silence.
- We return to our places down the centre aisle, keeping 2 metres from the person in front.
- Is your wish to leave after receiving Holy Communion you may do so. If you wish to remain a final blessing.
- Newsletters must be taken home DO NOT leave them in the church or at the back of the Church as they could risk spreading germs.

#### **AFTER MASS**

- Volunteers needed to help the church to be cleaned and surfaces sanitised.
- Thank you for your cooperation and understanding at this difficult time.
