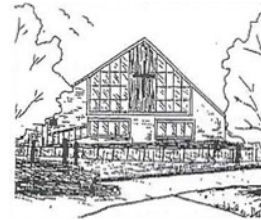

Reading: 1 KINGS 19:9,11-13 **Second Reading:** Romans 9:1-5 **Gospel:** Matthew 14: 22-33

Earlier this week, the Government issued further instructions to places of worship:

1. Worshippers should limit their interactions with anyone they meet at church; they should maintain social distancing from anyone outside their household.
2. People are also strongly encouraged to wear face coverings in enclosed public spaces where there are people they do not normally meet, such as a church. Then, at lunchtime on Friday, the Prime Minister announced that from **today Saturday 8 August face masks** or coverings must be worn in all places where members of the public mix, including places of worship.
