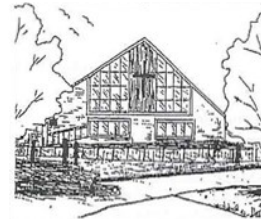

## **INFORMATION- FIRST HOLY COMMUNION 2020**
