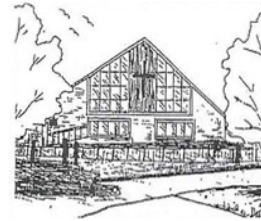

Reopening Church for the celebration of Sunday Mass

We are delighted to be able to open our doors to you all once again. You will notice that your Church is looking a bit different these days. We have brought in various measures to ensure the safety of our parishioners and stewards while coronavirus is still prevalent in our society.

Our Sunday Mass on Saturday evening 4th July at 6.30 pm MHR and on Sunday 5th July we have Masses at 9.00am at St Dominic's Church 11.00 am At MHR. Masses will be shorter. Since the pandemic begun the obligation to attend Sunday Mass has been removed by the Bishops of England and Wales

The capacity of the church has been reduced in line with Government guidance and there will be a maximum number of approx. 120 people allowed in to Church during each Mass and social distancing must be observed and the hygiene regulations at all times.

We are doing our best to ensure the health and safety of parishioners coming to the Church therefore a few guidelines will need to be followed.

- Please do **NOT** come to church if you have COVID-19 symptoms or have been contacted by the NHS Track and Trace service.
- Entry to the church will be on a first come first served basis and social distancing will be required when queuing outside.
- If possible can you not drive to church as space in the Car Park will be strictly limited.
- On arrival you will directed by a steward to sanitize your hands.
- Please bring you own face mask.
- There will be no singing during Mass.
- There will be a box at the back of the church for your offertory envelopes.
- The Toilets will be closed until further notice.
- Please COOPERATE with the stewards and follow their directions on entry/exit and during the distribution of Holy Communion.

Please note that Most Holy Redeemer Church is open daily **EXPOSITION OF BLESSED SACRAMENT** for private prayer :

Mondays, Wednesdays & Fridays

10am-12pm

At the meantime, the church is open for Private prayer. We have been instructed that the Church cannot be opened unless there are at least two "stewards" in the Church throughout the times of opening. With more volunteers, we can be open for longer hours. If you are not considered 'vulnerable' to the coronavirus and would like to volunteer stewards to ensure the church can open safely.
