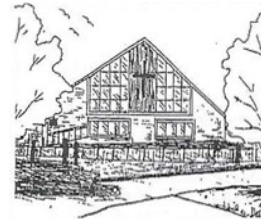

CORONAVIRUS - LONDON PLACED INTO TIER 2 - As London has been placed in the new Tier 2, places of worship are allowed to remain open - provided we maintain a "COVID-19 secure" environment. The latest instructions from the Government, which will have an impact on how we behave in the church itself, state: "no one must mix indoors with anyone who they do not live with (or have formed a support bubble with) . Outdoors, you can meet in groups of up to 6 people". **The wearing of face masks is now a legal obligation.**
