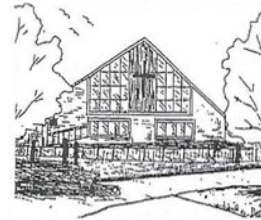

11th October 2020

Reading: Isaiah 25:6-10 **Second Reading:** Philippians 4:12-14,19-20 **Gospel:** Matthew 22:1-14



In today's Gospel, Jesus speaks to us about the joy of heaven, the invitation he has given us to join him there forever, and about how we need to respond to that invitation. He does so within the context of a parable about salvation history in which he indicates, basically, how NOT to respond. He concludes the parable by saying, "Many are invited, but few are chosen." In order that we may be numbered among the "chosen few," let's pay close attention to what he tells us today.
