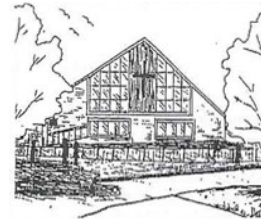

## Twenty-Fourth Sunday of the Year (A)

13th September 2020

**Reading:** Ecclesiasticus 27:30-28:7 **Second Reading:** Romans 14:7-9 **Gospel:** Matthew 18:21-35



Peter went up to Jesus and said, 'Lord, how often must I forgive my brother if he wrongs me? As often as seven times?' Jesus answered, ' Not seven, I tell you , but seventy-seven times.' ( Matthew 18:21-22).

In the Our Father which has a condition attached: *Forgive us our trespasses as we forgive those who trespass against us.* Those are some of the most healing words in scripture. They are also some of the most difficult words in scripture. We might not want to forgive others, but the pain we have received from others is minor in comparison to the gifts God has given us. Look at all that we have received from the Lord. We have received love, the great gift of living eternally in God's love.
