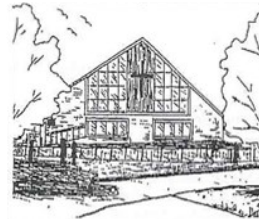

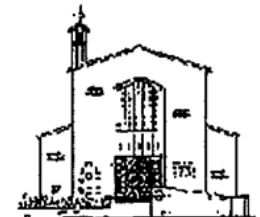

CORONAVIRUS - ESSEX PLACED INTO TIER 2 - As London has been placed in the new Tier 2, places of worship are allowed to remain open - provided we maintain a "COVID-19 secure" environment. Outdoors, you can meet in groups of up to 6 people". **The wearing of face masks is now a legal obligation.**
