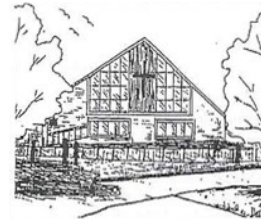

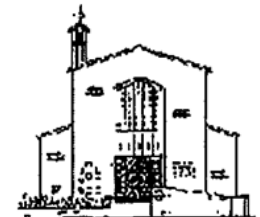

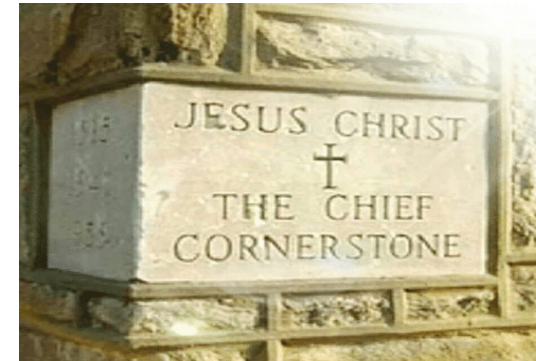
Twenty-Seventh Sunday of the Year (A)
