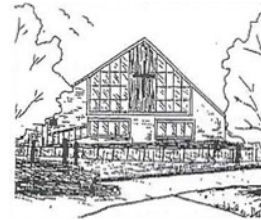

Sometimes we might promise to do something but all the while knowing, deep down, that it is a promise we may never keep!

Today's Gospel tells the story of two sons- one who makes an extravagant display of obedience, the other who refuses his father's request. When it comes to putting the promise into action, the roles are reversed.

We can learn from the first son-the one who said he wouldn't go but later changed his mind and went. To change one's mind is sometimes regarded as a weakness. But this not always the case. To change one's mind can mean to repent, that is to think again. It takes humility to admit one's mistake, and courage to put it right .

Many of the greatest saints in the history of the Church were sinners who initially said 'no' to God, but later changed their minds ie repented. St Augustine is perhaps the best known example, but there are many, many others.

REMINDER COVID-19

Procedure for Application

Applications for admission in September 2021 must be made via the online form on. The Campion School's website: thecampionschool.org.uk/admissions by the **Closing Date of 4.00 pm on Friday, 23rd October 2020**. This is in addition to the Consortium Co-ordination Form required by the Local Education Authority where you live. A prospectus, including details of how to apply via the Campion School website, will be online from Thursday, 24th September. **Please note that you will also need to obtain a Certificate of Catholic Practice when you apply to the school. This will involve you meeting with your Parish Priest at a time specified by him.**
