

REMINDER: TIER 4 RESTRICTIONS

In light of the severe rise in COVID infections in this area, it is worth reminding ourselves of the rules that are in place for places of worship in Tier 4 areas. Whilst we are allowed to remain open for worship and private prayer, we have a responsibility to re-double our efforts to keep our church and community free from the coronavirus. You may find some of these restrictions very difficult as we are used to greeting others and chatting with them. We are told that the virus loves social contact. Please note: a "support bubble" is a household that has joined with a single person who lives on their own.

- 1. In the church building, you must not meet with friends and family unless they are part of your household (or support bubble).
- **2.** Before and after Mass, you must not mingle or interact with anyone from outside your household (or support bubble).
- **4.**You must also not meet with people outside of your household (or support bubble) in most outdoor public venues. Outside of the church building you may speak, one-to-one, with another person.
- **5.** You should maintain strict social distancing at all times (at least one metre, preferably more).
- **6.** Face coverings must be worn over the mouth and nose (unless there is a medical or other exemption).
- 7. Prayer or study groups must not take place in person.
- **8**. Funerals can be attended by a maximum of 30 people. Anyone working is not counted in these limits. Social distancing should be maintained between people who do not live together (or share a support bubble).
- 9. Weddings should only take place in exceptional circumstances (for example, an urgent marriage where one of those getting married is seriously ill and not expected to recover, or is to undergo debilitating treatment or life-changing surgery). They can only take place with up to 6 people (anyone working is not included).

This is the law and the police have the powers to enforce these legal restrictions, including the issue of fines (fixed penalty notices) of £200, doubling for further breaches up to a maximum of £6,400.
