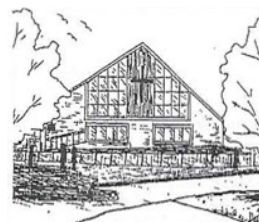

LOCKDOWN THIRD RESTRICTION

You are allowed to leave home to attend or visit a place of worship for communal worship, or for a funeral or an event related to a death. You may also attend a burial ground or a remembrance garden, or to attend a wedding ceremony. You must follow the guidance on the safe use of places of worship and you must not mingle with anyone outside of your household or support bubble when attending a place of worship.

Weddings, funerals and religious, belief-based or commemorative events linked to someone's death are all subject to limits on the numbers that can attend, and weddings and civil ceremonies may only take place in exceptional circumstances.

MIXING OR SOCIALISING - Inside the church building you may only mix or socialise with people from your household or bubble. Outside (with social distancing) you may talk with one other person from outside your household or bubble.

SOCIAL DISTANCING- Please keep at least 1 metre from anyone who is not a member of your household or bubble (2 metres is preferable).

FACE MASKS - It is now legal requirement that facemasks or coverings before, during and after services or entering all places of worship (unless you are medical exempt or under 11 yrs) .

SANITISE HANDS - Please use the sanitising gel provided at the church doors.

HYGIENE - Please avoid touching or kiss crucifix, statues, icons or other images and objects in the church.

FUNERALS can be attended by a maximum of 30 people. Anyone working is not counted in these limits. Social distancing should be maintained between people who do not live together (or share a support bubble).

WEDDINGS should only take place in exceptional circumstances (for example, an urgent marriage where one of those getting married is seriously ill and not expected to recover, or is to undergo debilitating treatment or life-changing surgery). They can only take place with up to 6 people (anyone working is not included).

NB. Anyone displaying symptoms of Covid-19, or who has reason to believe that they have been in contact with someone who has, should not attend church or volunteer in any capacity until they have received medical advice that it is safe to do so.
