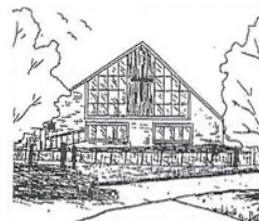

Pope Francis's Words

Do you want to fast this Lent ?

- Fast from hurting words and say kind words.
- Fast from sadness and be filled with gratitude.
- Fast from anger and be filled with patience.
- Fast from pessimism and be filled with hope.
- Fast from worries and trust in God.
- Fast from complaints and contemplate simplicity.
- Fast from pressures and be prayerful.
- Fast from bitterness and fill your heart with joy.
- Fast from selfishness and be compassionate to other.
- Fast from grudges and be reconciled.
- Fast from words and be silent so you can listen.

VACCINES against COVID-19 - The Bishops of England & Wales are encouraging all to take up the offer of the vaccine when it is offered. Pope Francis has already received his vaccine recently. He said that ethically, getting a vaccine against the virus should be a duty for everyone “It is an ethical option because you risk your health, your life, but you also risk the lives of others...it is something one must do”.

THE GOVERNMENT’S CAUTIOUS - “Road Map” out of lockdown is a reminder that Covid-19 and its variants remain a very real threat. We are still receiving details from the Government and the Bishops’ Conference, but the key elements are:

1. Restrictions will remain tightly in place for Holy Week and Easter; we will arrange extra Masses and services where possible.
2. Baptisms will be possible from 17th May, with up to 30 guests.
3. First Holy Communion dates for those parents opt out last year can now go ahead after 21st June.
