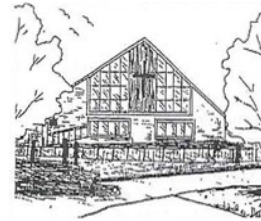

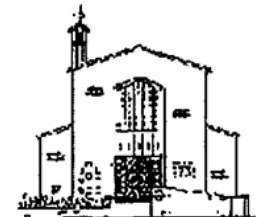

COVID-19 UPDATES

- In compliance with the Government's directives on Test & Trace,
