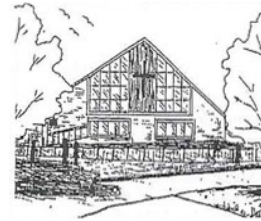

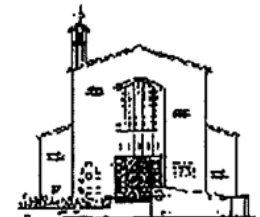

LOCKDOWN EASING FROM MONDAY 17TH MAY 2021

In church, the wearing of face masks and social distancing are still required.

The church seating capacity for weekend Masses remains: 130max at Most Holy Redeemer and 110max at St Dominic's Church.

The main changes for us are the numbers permitted at the following events:

Baptisms: 30 people, Funerals: The restriction on numbers attending funerals will be lifted the only cap will be the venue capacity, as the same for weekend Mass.

Weddings: 30 people.

The next step in lockdown easing is due from 21 June - possibly allowing full seating capacity once more.

BAPTISM- Parents wishing to have their child baptised at Most Holy Redeemer and St Dominic's Church will now have to produce **a copy of Parents' Baptismal Certificate required and utility bill** with the completed Parish Baptismal Form.

1. Reside and regularly practice in the parish of Most Holy Redeemer Church and St Dominic..
2. If you are new to the parish, you should now think about making Sunday Mass part of your regular practice and make yourself known to Fr Joseph.
3. Baptism doesn't mean that your child will automatically be admitted to a Catholic school.

FIRST HOLY COMMUNION CATCH-UP - Our First Holy Communion Children for 2020 were unable to do the preparation course last year due to the pandemic. **For parents who have submitted the application form before the dateline Sunday 6th December 2020.** They are 25 parents who submitted the form in time. Parent meeting will be on Wednesday 1st September 21 at 7pm. The first session of the course will begin on Thursday 2nd September 21 at 6.30pm. Thank you for your patience and commitment.
