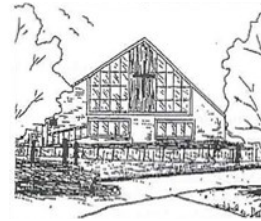

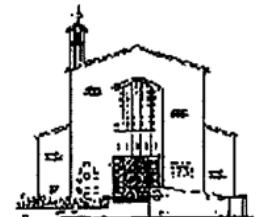

**BAPTISMS** - I am delighted to finally be in a position to be able to start celebrating Baptisms again. However, as you might well imagine there is a significant backlog of baptisms and many parents making enquiries about this sacrament. To help you make a decision about your child's baptism, you need to:

1. Reside and regularly practice in the parish of Most Holy Redeemer Church and St Dominic.. If you are new to the parish, you should now think about making Sunday Mass part of your regular practice and make yourself known to Fr Joseph. **One Parent must be baptised Catholic and must produce Baptism Certificate with application form.**

**ASCENSION DAY (HOLY DAY OF OBLIGATION)** - Thursday of this week is Ascension Day, a Holy Day of Obligation. **Masses at 9.30am at St Dominic's Church, and 7.30pm at the Most Holy Redeemer.**
