ELEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B)

First Reading: Ezekiel 17:22-24 **Second Reading:** 2 Cor 5:6-10 **Gospel:** Mk 4:26-16-34
13th June 2021



The Kingdom of God is like a mustard seed...
the smallest of all the seeds on the earth.
But once it is sown, it springs up
and becomes the largest of plants.
- Mark 4:31-32

"It is the smallest of the seeds, yet it grows into the biggest shrub of them all."

Both the parables in today's Gospel point to the role that we are called to play in God's plan. He takes care of the major part and leaves us with a small role. However, the role he has assigned to us is fundamental.

The farmer has to first of all scatter the seed and only then will God be able to do the rest, ie making the seed sprout, grow and bear fruit. Likewise, although the mustard seed itself is small, it has to be first sown into the ground. Once it is sown then its hidden ability to grow into the greatest of shrubs is triggered and it becomes one in which even birds can take shelter. Since "a journey of a thousand miles begins with a single step" we are given the task of taking a decisive step and play a crucial role.

LOCKDOWN EASING

1. Sanitising hands on entry to churches. No hand sanitisation is necessary as you leave.
2. The wearing of face masks and social distancing are still required.
3. The Bidding Prayers or Prayer of the Faithful has been restored.
4. We have returned to the normal practice of responding individually as we receive Holy Communion: the Eucharist Minister or Priest will say 'The Body of Christ' the communicant may reply, 'Amen.'
5. Currently single small group of singers will be allowed. This should be limited to groups of no more than 6, with social distancing being maintained.
6. There is no restriction on the number of people attending a funeral, so this now depends on the safe capacity of the church.
7. **30** people may be present at a baptism.
8. **30** people may be present at a wedding.

BAPTISM - Parents wishing to have their child baptised at Most Holy Redeemer and St Dominic's Church will now have to produce **a copy of Parents' Baptismal Certificate required and utility bill** with the completed Parish Baptismal Form.

1. Reside and regularly practice in the parish of Most Holy Redeemer Church and St Dominic..
2. If you are new to the parish, you should now think about making Sunday Mass part of your regular practice and make yourself known to Fr Joseph.
3. Baptism doesn't mean that your child will automatically be admitted to a Catholic school.
