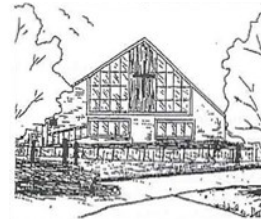

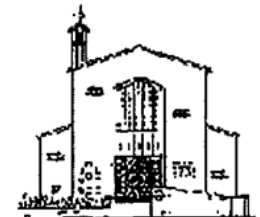

THE BODY & BLOOD OF CHRIST (B)

First Reading: Ex 24:3-8 **Second Reading:** Heb 9:11-15 **Gospel:** Mk 14:12-16, 22-26
6th June 2021



On Maundy Thursday we commemorated the institution of the Last Supper. So what did Jesus mean when he spoke of eating his flesh and drinking his blood? Whatever Jesus meant. It is good news because the bread of his flesh is given for the life of the world. Those who eat it will have life in them, and unlike those who were miraculously fed in the desert, they will live forever. Gift of bread and wine become the whole self and life of Jesus. Jesus Christ, the living sacrifice of the new covenant, becomes present under the outward forms of bread and wine.

LOCKDOWN EASING

1. Sanitising hands on entry to churches. No hand sanitisation is necessary as you leave.
2. The wearing of face masks and social distancing are still required.
3. The Bidding Prayers or Prayer of the Faithful has been restored.
4. We have returned to the normal practice of responding individually as we receive Holy Communion: the Eucharist Minister or Priest will say 'The Body of Christ' the communicant may reply, 'Amen.'
5. Currently single small group of singers will be allowed. This should be limited to groups of no more than 6, with social distancing being maintained.
6. There is no restriction on the number of people attending a funeral, so this now depends on the safe capacity of the church.
7. **30** people may be present at a baptism.
8. **30** people may be present at a wedding.

BAPTISM- Parents wishing to have their child baptised at Most Holy Redeemer and St Dominic's Church will now have to produce **a copy of Parents' Baptismal Certificate required and utility bill** with the completed Parish Baptismal Form.

1. Reside and regularly practice in the parish of Most Holy Redeemer Church and St Dominic..
2. If you are new to the parish, you should now think about making Sunday Mass part of your regular practice and make yourself known to Fr Joseph.
3. Baptism doesn't mean that your child will automatically be admitted to a Catholic school.
