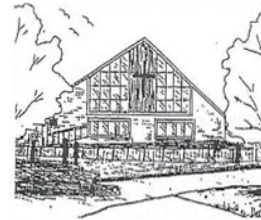

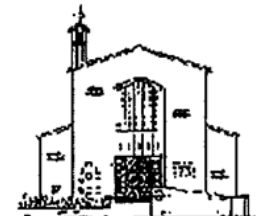

FIFTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B)

First Reading: Amos 7:12-15

Second Reading: Eph 1:3-14

Gospel: Mk 6:7-13

11th July 2021



In today's Gospel, Jesus sends out the disciples in pairs to support one another, teaching others the message of love and repentance they have seen and learnt from him. They are to carry nothing other than their staff, but to trust in God's love and rely on the hospitality of others. If they are not welcomed, they are not to make a scene, but simply 'shake off the dust from under their feet', then move on.

Let's pray that we show Jesus's message in our love for those we encounter each day. We ask to be witnesses to the joy of our faith in the way in which we live our lives.

GOVERNMENT UPDATES ON FUTURE COVID RESTRICTIONS

At present restrictions in the Parishes will remain in place until Government and Diocesan guidance gives us permission to change them. In order to reassure all members of the congregation, it will be important to consider how best to introduce any future changes in an appropriate manner. Thank you for your co-operation.

1. Sanitising hands on entry to churches. No hand sanitisation is necessary as you leave.
2. The wearing of face masks and social distancing are still required.
3. The Bidding Prayers or Prayer of the Faithful has been restored.
4. We have returned to the normal practice of responding individually as we receive Holy Communion: the Eucharist Minister or Priest will say 'The Body of Christ' the communicant may reply, 'Amen.'
5. Currently single small group of singers will be allowed. This should be limited to groups of no more than 6, with social distancing being maintained.
6. There is no restriction on the number of people attending a funeral, so this now depends on the safe capacity of the church.
7. 30 people may be present at a baptism.
8. 30 people may be present at a wedding.
