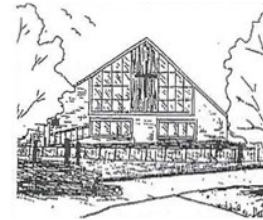

LIFTING OF COVID RESTRICTIONS AS OF 19TH JULY

With the lifting of legal restrictions from Monday 19 July we have received guidance from the bishops – who, in turn, have received advice from the Government’s Task Force on Places of Worship and Public Health England. Whilst the number of hospitalisations and deaths is much lower than previous waves; there is still concern about the long-term health implications of becoming infected.

We all have a responsibility to ensure that we keep each other safe; the virus is still with us and the number of infections is rising. For the time-being we are encouraged to continue with the following:

1. Sanitising of hands on entry into church.
2. **FACE MASK COVERINGS** to be worn while in Church; this is to protect yourself and others from being infected. I ask for your co-operation.
3. **TRACK AND TRACE** remains in operation
4. The church doors and windows will be open to ensure the greatest ventilation.
5. Cleaning of ‘high frequency touch points’ after each act of worship.
6. Holy water stoups at the entrance to churches are to be left empty. People wishing to receive holy water may bring a filled bottle which I can bless it privately.
7. The physical Sign of Peace remains suspended.
8. Holy Communion remains under one kind and distributed in the hand only (not directly to the mouth).
9. Restrictions on Social distancing is removed. However, people should respect each other’s personal space.
10. The ‘One Way’ system will continue to be used for exiting the church.
11. Congregational singing can recommence; it is recommended that this be phased in gently and that anyone singing in the body of the church should wear a face covering.
12. Altar servers may return to duty.
13. Those with ‘symptoms’ or who receive a National Health notification are not to attend Mass and should self-isolate until tested negative. This also includes if you have a cold or flu symptoms.
14. Please get the vaccine, if you have not already done so.
