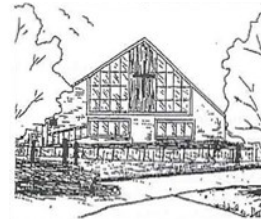

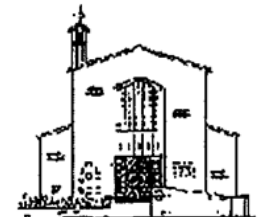

TWENTY-EIGHT SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME (B)

First Reading: Wisdom 7:7-11 Second Reading: Hebrews 4:12-13 Gospel: Mt: 10:17-30

10th October 2021

The Gospel is a discipleship story. The Jews believed that the prosperity of the rich was a sign of God's blessing. But Jesus gives us so many reminders of the dangers of wealth in his parables, because the call of money, status and security is so attractive and alluring that it can easily take our minds and hearts away from God, and make us selfish and unloving, hoarding instead of generous.

Money, in itself, is neither good nor bad. It can be hoarded for selfish use, it can be spent excessively and slowly for status reasons, or it can be shared with those who have less than we do. What we decide to do with what we have is one way of telling where our heart truly lies.

Jesus tells us that we cannot serve two masters: it is God or money. It is a question of trust and dependence. Do we trust in what we have accumulated, or do we depend on God?

It's important to understand that Jesus wasn't condemning wealth. Faith and wealth can coexist. Indeed, the young man probably a good example to others; he kept all the commandments suggests that he was a good-living and respectable young man. But he suffered from one defect, which can afflict anyone whatever their level of personal possessions. He could not let go of what gave him a sense of security in this life. The essence of Christian faith is to put one's trust in God, and to rely on God as the sole source of security and well-being.

CORONAVIRUS PRECAUTIONS

Although the Government has removed most restrictions, in common with many Catholic churches throughout the country, we ask that people continue to:

1. **TRACK AND TRACE** remains in operation.
2. Sanitise of hands on enter and leave the Church.
3. **Wear Face Mask** coverings properly - to protect others from being infected.
4. The Church windows and doors will remain open to ensure the greatest ventilation.
5. Keep to the new seating arrangements - sit wherever they can find sufficient space and leave at least 1 metre between themselves and people who are not members of their household or bubble.
6. Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and distributed in the hand (not directly to the mouth).
9. The 'One Way' system will continue to be used for exiting the Church.
10. Those with 'symptoms' or who receive a National Health notification are not to attend Mass and should self-isolate until tested negative. This also includes if you have a cold or flu symptoms.
