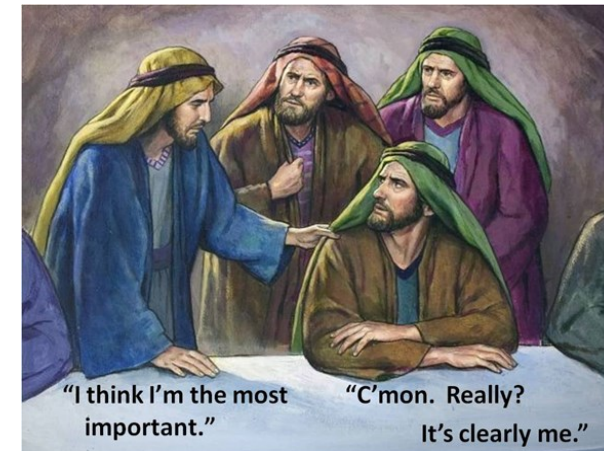

CORONAVIRUS PRECAUTIONS

Although the Government has removed most restrictions, in common with many Catholic churches throughout the country, we ask that people continue to:

1. **TRACK AND TRACE** remains in operation.
2. Sanitise of hands on enter and leave the Church.
3. **Wear Face Mask** coverings properly - to protect others from being infected.
4. The Church windows and doors will remain open to ensure the greatest ventilation.
5. Keep to the new seating arrangements - sit wherever they can find sufficient space and leave at least 1 metre between themselves and people who are not members of their household or bubble.
6. Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and distributed in the hand (not directly to the mouth).
9. The 'One Way' system will continue to be used for exiting the Church.
10. Those with 'symptoms' or who receive a National Health notification are **not to attend Mass** and should self-isolate until tested negative. **This also includes if you have a cold or flu symptoms.**
