Have you ever heard the saying, "The family that prays together stays together"? It's actually a trademarked slogan used the world over by religious clergy and families of goodwill. It speaks to the notion that prayer strengthens bonds in families. When that bond grows, love grows, and a loving family is the best way to help children find happiness and love in their lives. No matter one's faith, Catholic families strive for nurturing, support, unconditional love, faith, stability and mentorship. Prayer provides that.

CORONAVIRUS PRECAUTIONS

Although the Government has removed most restrictions, in common with many Catholic churches throughout the country, we ask that people continue to:

1. **TRACK AND TRACE** remains in operation.
2. Sanitise of hands on enter and leave the Church.
3. Wear face coverings properly - to protect others from being infected.
4. The Church windows and doors will remain open to ensure the greatest ventilation.
5. Keep to the new seating arrangements - sit wherever they can find sufficient space and leave at least 1 metre between themselves and people who are not members of their household or bubble.
6. Holy Communion will continue to be under one kind and distributed in the hand (not directly to the mouth).
9. The 'One Way' system will continue to be used for exiting the Church.
10. Those with 'symptoms' or who receive a National Health notification are not to attend Mass and should self-isolate until tested negative. This also includes if you have a cold or flu symptoms.

BISHOP'S PASTORAL LETTER - Bishop Alan has sent a pastoral letter, which will be read at Masses today. He writes: 'Now, in the autumn of 2021, we find ourselves at a moment which will define how human beings respond to the challenges of Climate Change. In less than a month the United Nations Climate Change Conference will meet in Glasgow, and the decisions they make will affect us all. So today you are receiving information about what the Diocese is doing, and what you are invited to do, as individuals and as a parish. As part of this, each of us is asked to make three persona pledges, three ways in which we will act differently. This is not just another environmental campaign; it is an integral part of our faith. In making your personal pledges – in working to heal the planet, and in striving for justice for the poorest people in the world – you are a living witness to Jesus Christ: do not be afraid to tell people what you ae doing and why you are doing it.'
