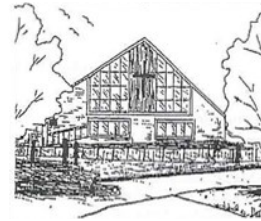

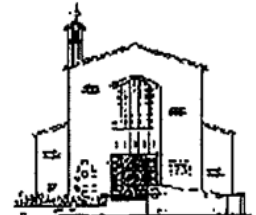

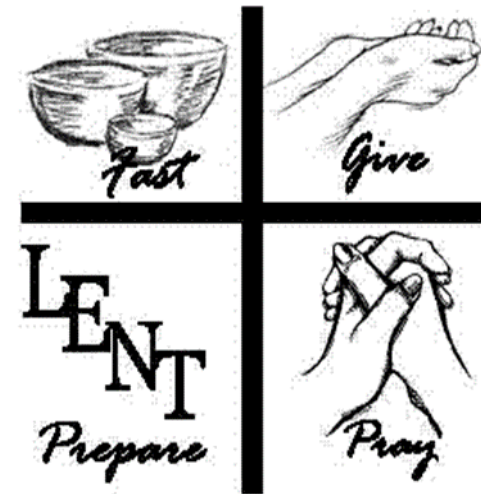

ASH WEDNESDAY: 2nd March, marks the beginning of the Holy Season of Lent. Mass with distribution of ashes in the Most Holy Redeemer Church at 9.30am, St Ursula's Federation School service at 11am and Mass 7.30pm (both at St Dominic's Church).

SEASON OF LENT - During the season of Lent there will be Stations of the Cross every Friday at MHR after 9.30am after Mass and St Dominic at 7pm followed by Mass at 7.30pm. During Lent we are encouraged to undertake practices of self-denial: Fasting, Almsgiving and spend more time dedicated to Prayer. Please make a very special effort to attend at least one Friday evening.

LENT READINGS - The Scripture readings for Lent are particularly rich and a major source of help in living a good Lent. Fr Adrian Graffy, parish priest, Scripture scholar, and member of the Pontifical Biblical Commission, has prepared commentaries on all the readings in the Liturgy of the Word at Mass throughout Lent, from Ash Wednesday to Good Friday.
