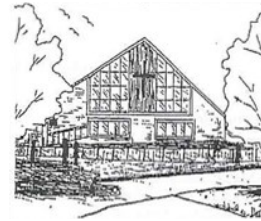

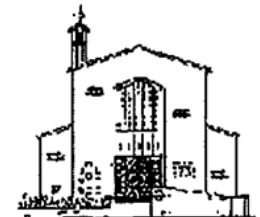

## SECOND SUNDAY OF LENT ( C )

13th MARCH 2022

**First Reading:** Genesis 15:5-12,17-18 **Second Reading:** Philippians 3:17-4:1 **Gospel:** Luke 9: 28-36



*Jesus takes his three followers up the mountain to pray, and this is a symbol of the withdrawal that must take place before he can be transfigured. The transfiguration is described as something that happened to Jesus himself first, before it was seen by the disciples. Note two points that are specific to St Luke's account:*

- the change happens while he is praying;
- Moses and Elijah were speaking to him about his passion
