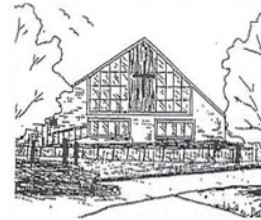

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD (C)

10TH APRIL 2022

First Reading: Isaiah: 50: 4-7 **Second Reading:** Philippians 2: 6-11 **Gospel:** Luke 23: 1-49

On this **Palm Sunday** we reflect upon a paradox of triumph and tragedy: the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on the one hand and the Gospel proclamation of the passion and death of Jesus on the other. And even in the tragedy of Good Friday there is the triumph of Easter; Jesus, crucified, risen and in our midst.

On **Holy Thursday** we will commemorate the Lord's Supper: there is the washing of feet (a symbol of service); and then the eating of a meal—a sacrificial meal—in which Jesus gives himself to us in the signs of bread and wine (a symbol of our oneness not only with God but also with the human family).

On **Good Friday** we meditate upon the passion and death of Jesus: the Garden of Gethsemane; the trial; the crucifixion; and the burial; the veneration of the cross; and then a simple communion service.

And at the **Easter vigil** we reflect upon the passage of Jesus from this earthly life through death into eternal life; the resurrection of Jesus is the pledge of our own liberation or deliverance from death or nothingness into eternal life. The Vigil includes: fire (a symbol of Jesus as the light who illuminates the darkness around us); it also includes the proclamation of the story of our salvation in the Scriptures; the renewal of our baptismal promises; and the Eucharist.

Easter proclaims that Jesus is Risen; alive among us, and especially alive in the sacramental life of our Catholic community. And so during this holiest of weeks let us enter as fully as possible into this paschal mystery (the dying and rising of Jesus) so that God can make us more grace-filled persons.

PALM SUNDAY - Today is Palm Sunday, the first day of Holy Week. To avoid possible dangers of spreading the covid-19 we will not gather outside for the blessing of the palms. This will take place in church. The Passion of Luke will be read.

HOLY THURSDAY - Our Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday will begin at 7.30 pm. At the end of Mass there will be the procession to the Altar of Repose, which reminds us of Jesus' walk to the Garden of Gethsemane. There will be the opportunity for private prayer in the church until 10.30pm.

GOOD FRIDAY - We would like the First Holy Communion children and their families to attend the Stations of the Cross for children at the Most Holy Redeemer Church on Friday 15th April. Please arrive by 10.15am. This will be followed by refreshments with arts and crafts in the Parish Hall. There will be a film "The Resurrection".

- The Good Friday service will begin at the usual time of 3 pm, at St Dominic (Fr Joseph) and Most Holy Redeemer's Church (Fr Gostling), the 'ninth hour' at which Jesus died on the cross. The Liturgy of the Word concludes with the General Intercessions. There will be individual veneration of the Cross by bowing or genuflect (no kissing of the feet of the Cross due to Covid). Holy Communion will be available at the end of the Service.

SATURDAY – THE EASTER VIGIL - This is the high point of the liturgical year, our celebration that 'Christ has died! Christ is risen! Christ will come again!' We will begin the service at 8 pm with the blessing of the fire and the lighting of the paschal candle at the back of the Church . Candles will be provided for each person to be lit from the paschal candle. The Easter Proclamation or Exsultet will be said. The Liturgy of the Word, with four Old Testament readings, will follow. The Alleluia will be sung and the Easter gospel proclaimed. The renewal of baptismal promises will be made at this Mass and at the other Masses on Easter Sunday.

EASTER SUNDAY - Masses as usual at 9am (Std) and 11 am (MHR)
