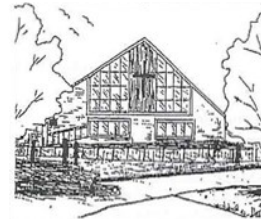

First Reading: Exodus: 3:1-8, 13-15 **Second Reading:** 1 Cor 10:1-6, 10-12 **Gospel:** Luke 13: 1-9



Today's Gospel has been called the Gospel of the second chance. The fig tree in Jesus' story was a very privileged tree because it was planted in a very special place—a vineyard. Yet in spite of this the tree was barren. Nevertheless, it was given another chance.

God is patient. The history of the Church is full of examples of barren fig trees that in time became fruitful in other words, sinners who repented and became saints.
