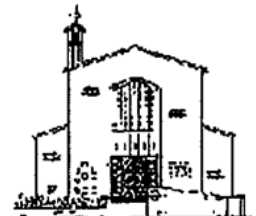

REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY

13TH NOVEMBER 2022

First Reading: Malachi 3:19-2 **Second Reading:** 2Thess: 3:7-12 **Gospel:** Luke 21:5-19



In the Jewish world of Jesus' time one of the ways of speaking about God's action in the world was known as apocalyptic. This type of language is found in the gospels when the evangelists are speaking about the end of time. The imagery is not taken literally but is symbolic of the hard times that people might have to endure before the final victory of good over evil. This reading from Luke looks towards the second coming of Christ and Jesus warns his followers not be distracted but to persevere in their faith for no harm will come to them. The preaching of Jesus is never aimed at frightening people into conversion so there is nothing Christian about using the Bible to predict a catastrophic end to the world.

NOVEMBER – MONTH OF THE HOLY SOULS November is the month when we especially remember our deceased member of our family, relatives and our loved ones. We also pray for them and offer Masses for the repose of their souls in the eternal life of God. Our custom here, for many years, is to leave the names of our loved ones before the altar throughout the month. Envelopes for this purpose are available at the back of the church; please place them in the offertory baskets, put them through the letter box at Priest's House. During the month of November we offer our prayers and Masses for them.
