29TH JANUARY 2023

First Reading: Zephaniah 2:3, 3:12-13 **Second Reading:** 1 Cor 1:26-31 **Gospel:** Matthew 5:1-12



Today's gospel is described by Pope Francis: 'This is the new law, the one we call the "the Beatitudes." It's the Lord's new law for us' (February 2016). It highlights attitudes of the heart rather than just a set of rules to be followed.

The beatitudes are the basic Christian ideals, not a moral code or a set of rules to avoid God's punishment. They aim to raise our perspective above the constraints of self-interest and gain.
