THE MOST HOLY TRINITY [A] **4TH JUNE 2023**

First Reading: Ex 34:4-6.8-9 Second Reading: 2 Cor 13:11-13 Gospel: John 3:16-18



Trinity 1425–27 by Andrei Rublev

The Icon (above) depicts three angels sitting at a table. On the table, there is a cup containing the head of a calf. In the background, Rubley painted a house (supposedly Abraham's house), a tree (the Oak of Mamre), and a mountain (Mount Moriah). The figures of angels are arranged so that the lines of their bodies form a full circle. At the time of Rublev, the Holy Trinity was the embodiment of spiritual unity, peace, harmony, mutual love and humility.
