TWENTY- SEVENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIMES [A] 8TH OCTOBER 2023

First Reading: Isaiah 5 1-7 Second Reading: Philippians 4: 6 - 9 Gospel: Matthew 21:33-43

In our Second Reading, St Paul's letter to the Philippians encouraged them to be people of faith. Today it offers us the same encouragement when we read it or listen to it being proclaimed. Paul's advice is quite straight-forward: "There is no need to worry; but if there is anything you need, pray for it, asking God for it with prayer and thanksgiving, and that peace of God, which is so much greater than we can understand, will guard your hearts and your thoughts in Christ Jesus."

The famous 20th century Saint Pio (commonly known as Padre Pio), offered much the same advice when he said: "Pray, hope and don't worry." St Paul's inspire words give us hope and consolation, and a reminder that we ought not to waste time worrying.

Paul's message clearly links the absence of worry in our lives with complete trust in God. When we learn to trust God totally, like the great saints did during their lives on earth, we will know that God's providential care is constantly looking after us, guiding us as we journey through our daily activities and protecting us from all harm and evil.

Jesus himself offered similar advice to Martha when he said to her:" You worry and fret about so many things, and yet so few are needed, indeed only one. It is Mary who has chosen the better part; it is not to be taken from her" (Lk 10:41 -42).

As you prepare for worship, please be sensitive to the needs of those who may wish to pray quietly. Before Mass, try to keep conversation to a minimum and avoid behaviour which could distract others. Please make sure Mobile Phones are switched off or on silent. Thank You for your co-operation.
