# FIFTH SUNDAY OF LENT (B)

17th March 2024

First Reading: Jeremiah 31:31 - 34 Second Reading: Hebrews 5:7 - 9 Gospel: John 12: 20 - 30

There is a hard pill to swallow in today's Gospel because being drawn to Christ will involve 'hating our life in this world'. To serve Jesus means to follow Him says the evangelist; and to follow Him means to follow Him to the cross, because that is where He is now heading. The letter to the Hebrews offers us this further reflection on the human condition: that we all learn to obey God through suffering. Jesus himself in his passion and death demonstrates the need for 'suffering as a way to obedience'.

Most of us are careful to avoid anything that might involve difficulty or suffering. We are tempted to surround ourselves with comforts, says St John Henry Newman, but these comforts corrupt our hearts and seduce us from God. It's just part of wanting to have things our own way and to be the centre of the world.

Yet, when we think about it, suffering is an ever present and important part of growing as a human being. The transformation from child to mature adult is no easy achievement. So it should not surprise us that suffering and sacrifice are also the way to grow in holiness. The main thing is not to fear sacrifice and to be willing to begin here and now to embrace the will of God in every moment of our lives.

'Easier said than done' you may say - and you would be right. But then it's not all down to us. It is the grace of Christ working within us which will refashion our will and transform our rebellious human spirit into loving and regular obedience. We only have to keep asking for that grace.
