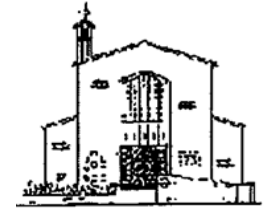

**11th August 2024**

**First Reading**: 1 Kings 19: 4-8 **Second Reading**: Ephesians 4: 30 - 5:2 **Gospel**: John 6:41 - 51

Ever felt like giving up? Elijah certainly did. In today's First Reading we meet a prophet who has had enough. Things are so bad for Elijah that after a day's journey into the wilderness he sits under a furze bush and begs God to take his life.

Life can be get on top of us sometimes. At one time or another, many of us will experience the feelings described in the anonymous poem:

**DON'T QUIT**

'When things go wrong as they sometimes will,  
When the road you're trudging seems all up hill,  
When the funds are low and the debts are high  
And you want to smile, but you have to sigh,  
When care is pressing you down a bit,  
Rest if you must, but don't you quit.'

We can 't always reach our destination under our own steam. It is at these times of struggle that we need to pause, to take refuge and to stock up with food for the journey.

Jesus tells us he is the living bread. 'Anyone who eats this bread will live forever'. In all our struggles, when we feel like giving up, he is there to give us nourishment for the journey. This gift is there for us to avail of in the Eucharist.
