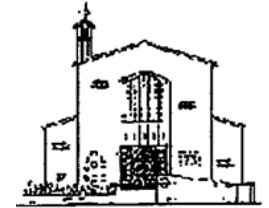

### **TWENTY - NINTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIMES (B)**

**20th October 2024**

**First Reading: Isaiah 53:10-11** **Second Reading: Hebrews 4:14-16** **Gospel: Mark 10:35-45**

Pope Francis' theme for 2024 World mission Sunday is rooted in the Gospel of Matthew: **"Go and invite everyone to the Banquet."** Here, Francis reflects on God's inclusive and urgent call to bring His love to everyone. Let us each take our part in this universal mission to spread the Gospel and, so, to invite all to experience the joy of Christ's message!

The Church, according to Vatican Council II, is *"missionary"* in her very nature because her founder, Jesus Christ, was the first missionary. God the Father sent God the Son, Incarnate in Jesus, His Christ, into the world with a message of God's love and salvation. Thus, the evangelizing mission of the Church is essentially the announcement of God's love, mercy, forgiveness, and salvation, as these are revealed to mankind through the life, death, and Resurrection of Jesus Christ our Lord. **How should we evangelize?** There are three ways: First by living an exemplary and transparent Christian life, Secondly by prayer, and finally by financial support. The first and most powerful means of preaching Christ is by living a truly Christian life.

Over one billion Catholics all over the world observe today as **World Mission Sunday**. This annual observance was instituted 98 years ago in 1926 by Pope Pius XI's Papal decree. Every year since then, the universal Church has dedicated the month of October to reflection on, and prayer for, the missions. On **World Mission Sunday**, Catholics gather to celebrate the Eucharist and to contribute to a collection for the work of evangelization around the world. This annual celebration gives us a chance to reflect on the importance of mission work for the life of the Church. It reminds us that we are one with the Church around the world and that we are all committed to carrying on the mission of Christ, however different our situations may be.
