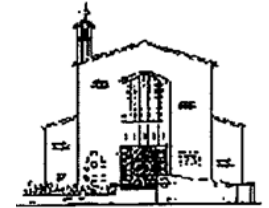

**10th November 2024**

**REMEMBRANCE SUNDAY**



**First Reading:** *1Kings 17:10-16* **Second Reading:** *Hebrews 9:24-28* **Gospel:** *Mark 12:38-44*  
November is the month in which we pray for the dead, and today is Remembrance Sunday when we honour those who died in the service of our country in war, especially the two great wars of the 20th century and some others minor conflicts such as Korea war, Vietnam war, Falkland, Iraq and Afghanistan, Ukraine and Middle East in which so many have lost their lives for the service of our country.

Since the Armistice was signed in November 1918, bringing an end to the First World War. Remembrance Sunday is the day traditionally put aside to remember all those who have given their lives for the peace and freedom we enjoy today. On this day people across the nation pause to reflect on the sacrifices made by our brave service men and women.

The heroism shown by so many soldiers men and women in the face of almost overwhelming suffering is something that should never be forgotten. We think of them as we place the wreaths of blood-red poppies on war memorial around Britain on this day.

For Catholic, praying for the dead is not just something we do on Remembrance Sunday but is a serious duty all through November.
