## TWENTY - EIGHTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME © 12th October 2025

First Reading: 2 Kings 5:14-17 Second Reading: 2 Timothy 2:8 – 8-13 Gospel: Luke 17:11-19 Many of us regularly turn to St Anthony for help in finding a lost items, while others enlist the help of St Jude for particularly 'hopeless' cases, or St (Padre) Pio when a loved one is sick or in hospital. We are very good at prayer when we need something, and have no problem turning to God in times of strife. But what about after storm has passed?

The leper in today's Gospel offers us a lesson in gratitude and faith. It is easy to ask for help, to call out 'Jesus Master! Take pity on us!' It is not so easy to appreciate the implications of what God is doing in our lives.

All of us have been hurt by ingratitude at one time or another. "Thank you" is precious phrase and its neglect can be very painful. Jesus in his humanity felt the hurt of being taken for granted as is clear from today's Gospel reading about the ten lepers. Jesus healed all of them of their dreadful affliction but only one of them bothered to come back to thank him.

One of the reasons why the Catholic Church places such emphasis on attending Mass on Sundays is because the **Eucharist** is the supreme expression of **thanksgiving**. At every Mass the Priest says: "Let us give thanks to the Lord our God" and the congregation reply: " It is right to give him thanks and praise."

It speaks to the notion that prayer strengthens bonds in families. When that bond grows, love grows, and a loving family is the best way to help children find happiness and love in their lives.
