

MAY THEY REST IN PEACE.

PALM SUNDAY OF THE PASSION OF THE LORD (A)

Sunday 29th March

First Reading: Isaiah 50: 4-7

Second Reading: Philippians: 2: 6-11

Gospel: Matthew 26:14-27:66

On this Palm Sunday we reflect upon a paradox of triumph and tragedy: the triumphal entry of Jesus into Jerusalem on the one hand and the Gospel proclamation of the passion and death of Jesus on the other. And even in the tragedy of Good Friday there is the triumph of Easter; Jesus, crucified, risen and in our midst.

Next Thursday, Friday and Saturday are known as the Triduum or three days.

On Thursday we will commemorate the Lord's Supper: there is the washing of feet (a symbol of service); and then the eating of a meal—a sacrificial meal—in which Jesus gives himself to us in the signs of bread and wine (a symbol of our oneness not only with God but also with the human family).

On Good Friday we meditate upon the passion and death of Jesus: the Garden of Gethsemane; the trial; the crucifixion; and the burial; the veneration of the cross; and then a simple communion service.

And at the Easter vigil we reflect upon the passage of Jesus from this earthly life through death into eternal life; the resurrection of Jesus is the pledge of our own liberation or deliverance from death or nothingness into eternal life. The Vigil includes: fire (a symbol of Jesus as the light who illuminates the darkness around us); it also includes the proclamation of the story of our salvation in the Scriptures; the renewal of our baptismal promises; and the Eucharist.

Easter proclaims that Jesus is risen; alive among us, and especially alive in the sacramental life of our Catholic community.
