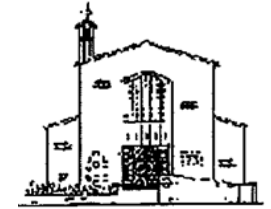

MAY THEY REST IN PEACE.

The Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (A) **(Corpus Christi)** **Sunday 7th June**

First Reading: Deuteronomy 8:2-3, 14b-16a **Second Reading: 1 Corinthians 10:16-17** **Gospel: John 6:51-58**

Today's feast originates in the spiritual visions of Saint Juliana from Liege in France. She entered a convent and began to experience visions which led her to agitate for a special feast commemorating the gift of the Eucharist. She died in 1258 and as a result of her efforts and her witness, six years later Pope Urban IV instituted the feast of Corpus Christi or the Body and Blood of the Lord throughout the whole church. It was primarily a processional feast that quickly spread throughout the Christian world.

The Eucharist was carried throughout a town or a village and people followed it. Walking behind the Lord in the Eucharist brought home to people that the Lord was present to them in all of their lives, that he accompanied them through all the ups and downs of their day to day living. In many parts of the world today the feast is still celebrated with traditional rituals involving music and dance, as each culture gives the feast its own particular hue and colour. Corpus Christi processions were a feature of our own celebration of the feast up until relatively recently. If you have been to Lourdes you will know that the daily Eucharist procession is one of the highlights of the pilgrimage.

We come to the Eucharist, especially the Sunday Eucharist, because the Lord calls us to the Eucharist to remind us that we do not live on bread alone but on every word that comes from the mouth of God, especially himself, the Word made flesh, the Bread of Life. As we draw life from him at the Eucharist, he sends us out to be a life-giving presence to one another. As we enter into a communion of love with the Lord in the Eucharist, he commissions us to build communities of love, in our homes, our parishes, our cities, and our world.
